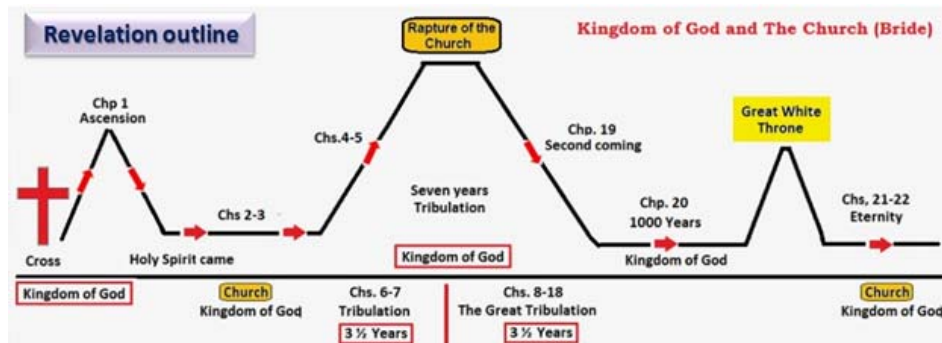
A camera system has been purchased at the price of \$328.00 and is in the process of being installed. This system will record when no one is present and will allow our Team to monitor everything happening when we are present.
